

- Lodging available includes two rooms each furnished with queen size beds. The rooms are arranged in a comfortable setting with telephones and televisions in each room.
- Carolyn and Willard are willing hosts always prepared to be of assistance and offer local information on the Nisga'a culture and tradition and various local points of interest.
- Currently the Naas has ROGERS cellular phone service. Internet service is available.

- Local drinking water is excellent.
- No grocery stores or restaurants in the community. However, a healthy supply of complimentary snacks is offered.

The Community & Region

Laxgalts'ap (Greenville) is found in the beautiful Nass Valley region of British Columbia. The name is of the Nisga'a Language and is one of four villages of the Nisga'a Nation. Laxgalts'ap is 147 kilometers northwest of Terrace and is accessible by Provincial Highway system on Nisga'a Highway 113.

There are many points of interest enroute to Laxgalts'ap such as the historic Nass River lava flows. The Pacific Ocean and its abundant fisheries are easily accessible from Laxgalts'ap. The entire area boasts of numerous picturesque small rivers, creeks, and streams abundant with fish and wildlife.

The natural surroundings are still in pristine form.

The local inhabitants, the Nisga'a tribe/clans have a rich history and culture that is depicted by colorful customs and ceremonies. There is always a special effort to introduce guests to the local culture and traditional happenings in the village of Laxgalts'ap.

The Nisga'a are among the first indigenous peoples to have signed a Treaty and now have the power to govern themselves and take control of their territory. For more information www.nisgaanation.ca.
